R: round

mr = magic ring

sc = single crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

sl st = slip stitch

BLO = back loops only

FO = finish off

[] = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row

() x 6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

Materials needed:

- Yarn (2.5mm): black, white, and green
- Crochet hook: 3.0 mm
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- Sewing needle, scissors
